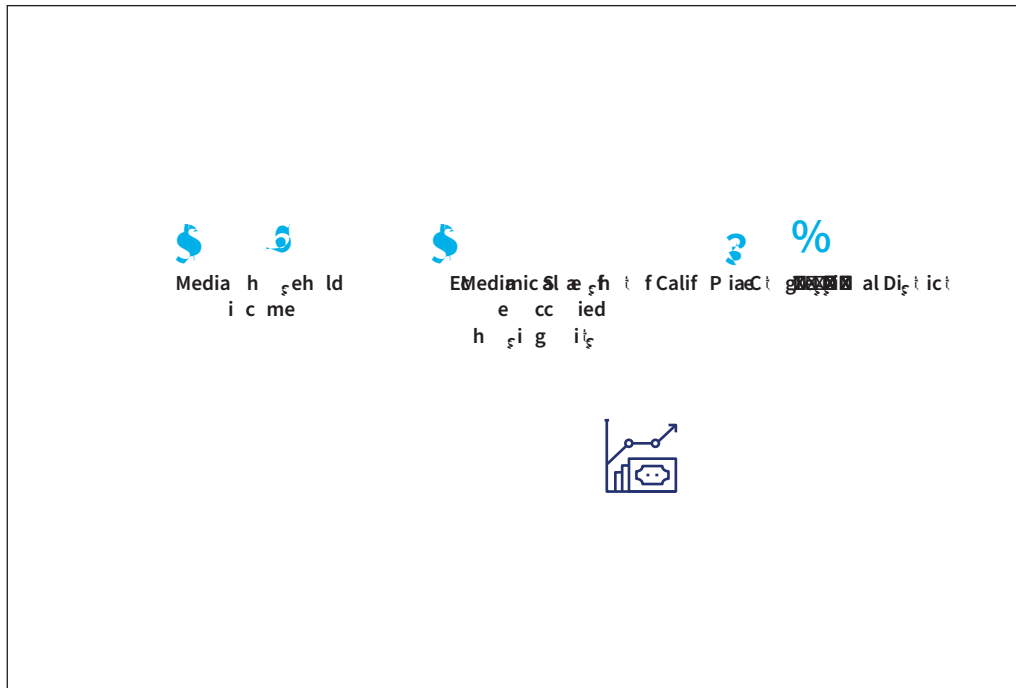


Home Affordability Matters: A National Issue

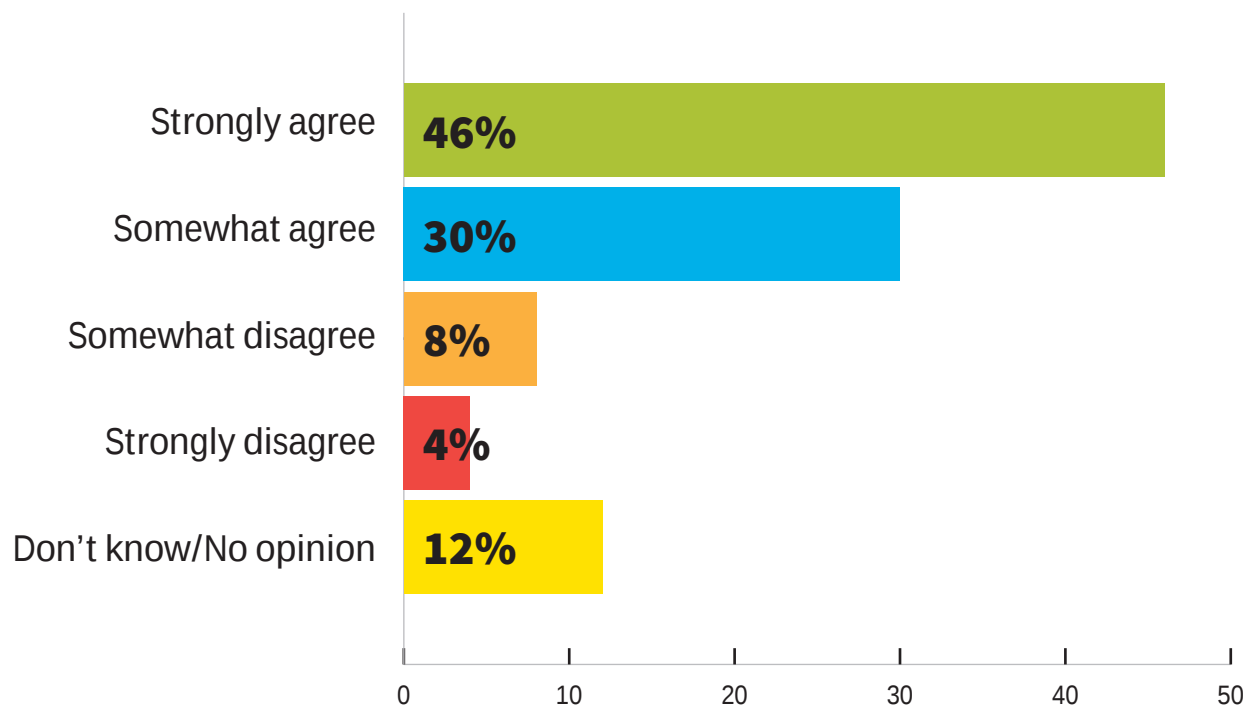

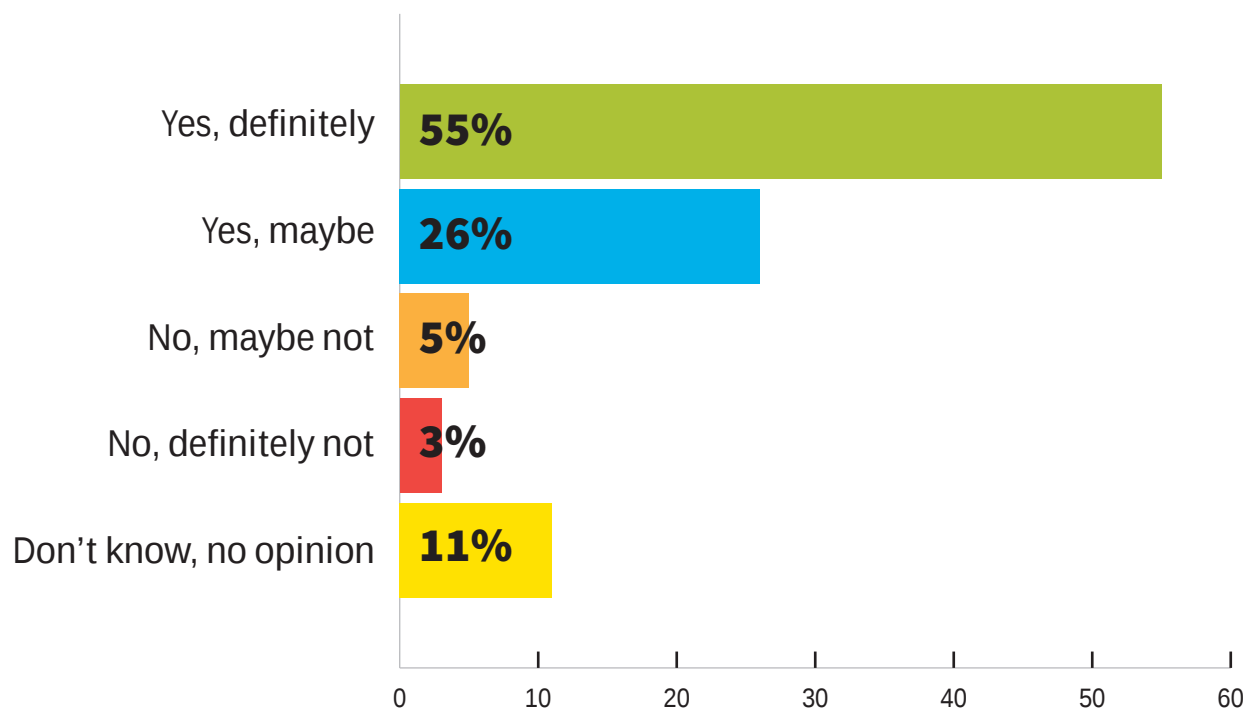

Do you agree or disagree that the election is a high quality and democratic process?

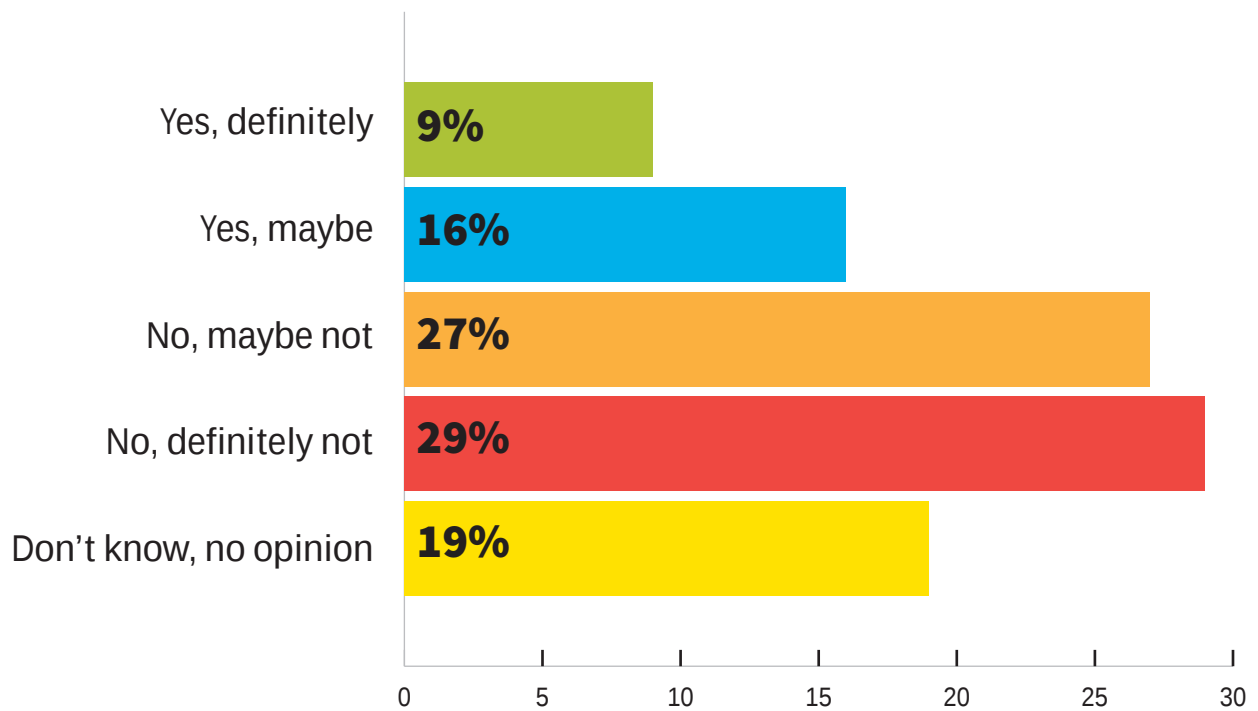


POLLING QUESTION 3: California Congressional District
