

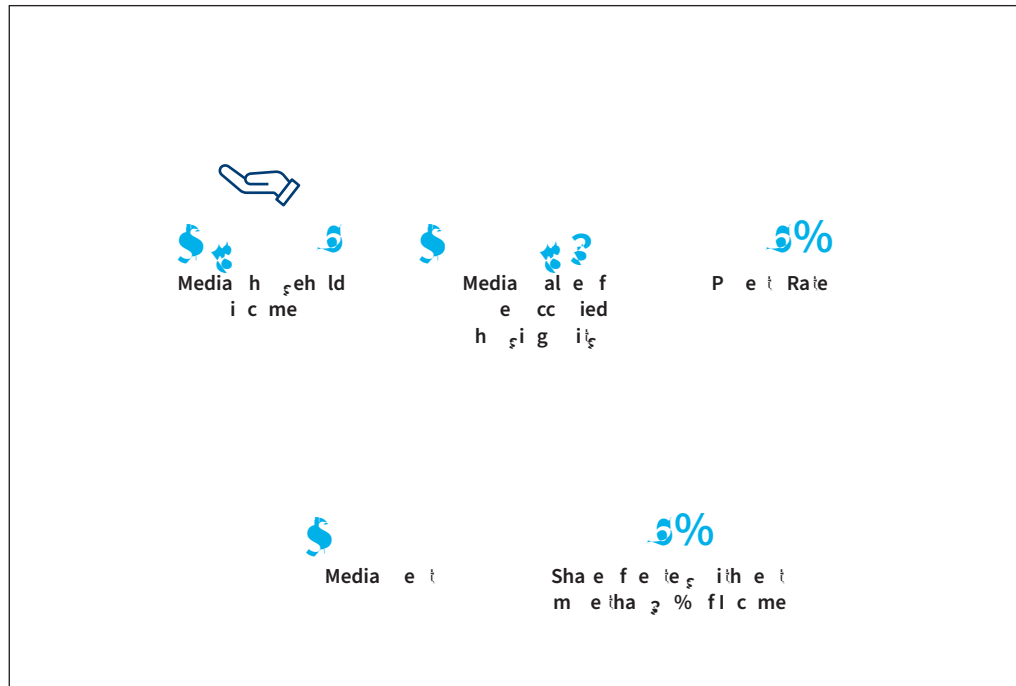
Home Affordability and Rental Market

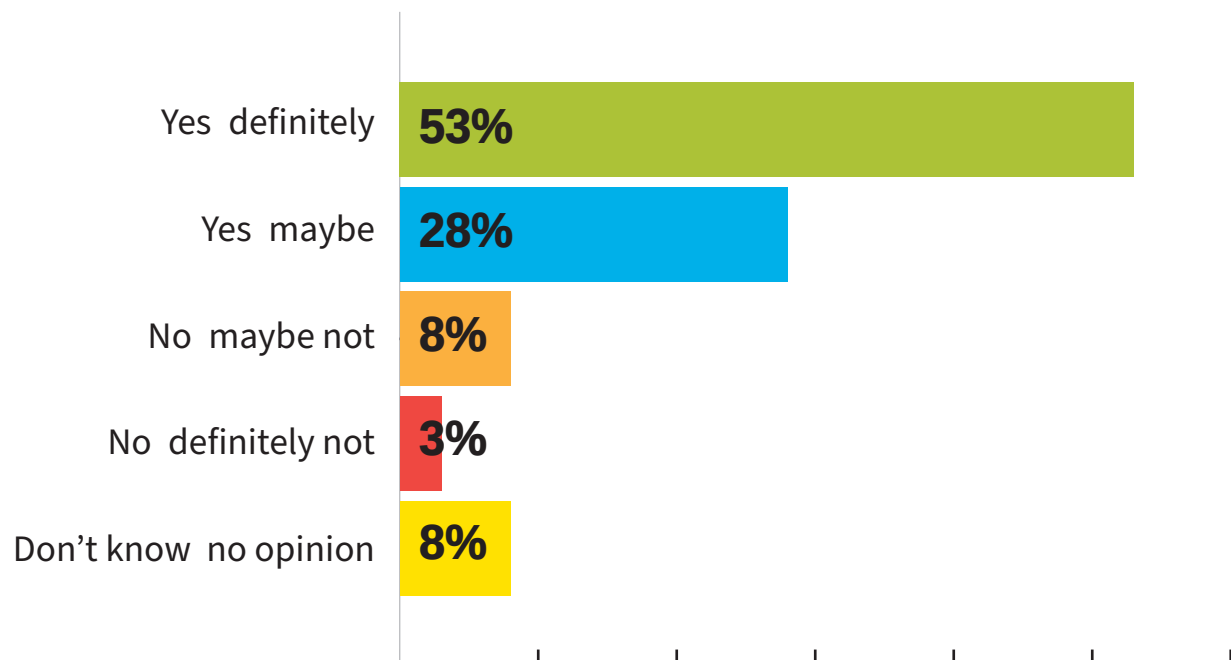
