

Below you will find a brief look at economic markers, as well as district residents' responses to surveys on important housing topics.



POLLING QUESTION 1 | California Congressional District 50


When it comes to housing issues, which of the following is more important to you personally?






POLLING QUESTION 3 | California Congressional District 50
