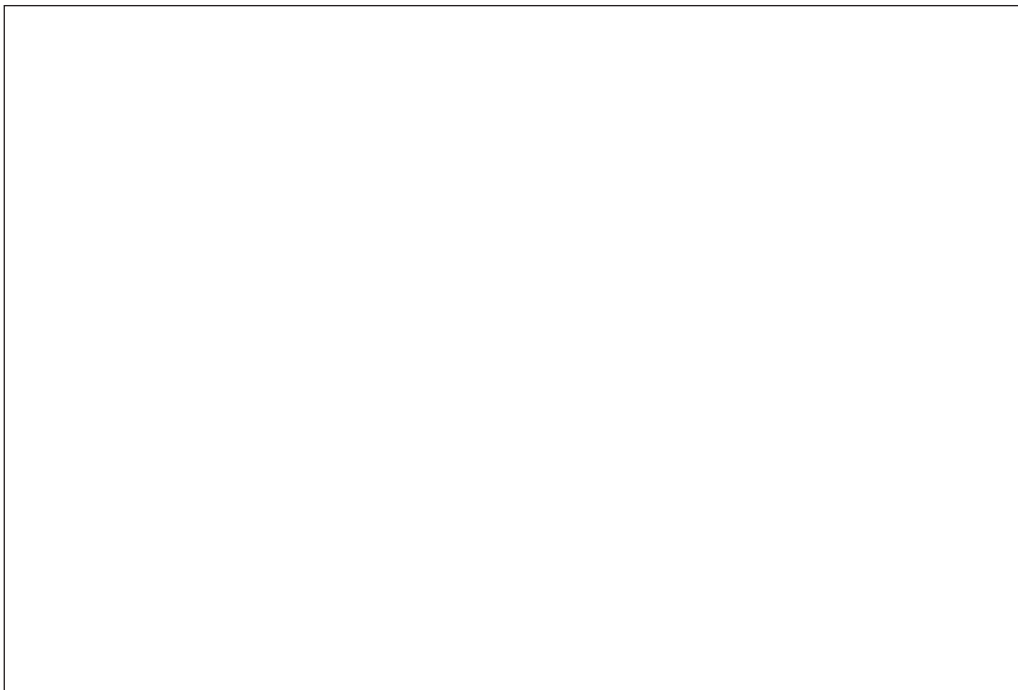


Housing Affordability Must Be Addressed Locally and Nationally

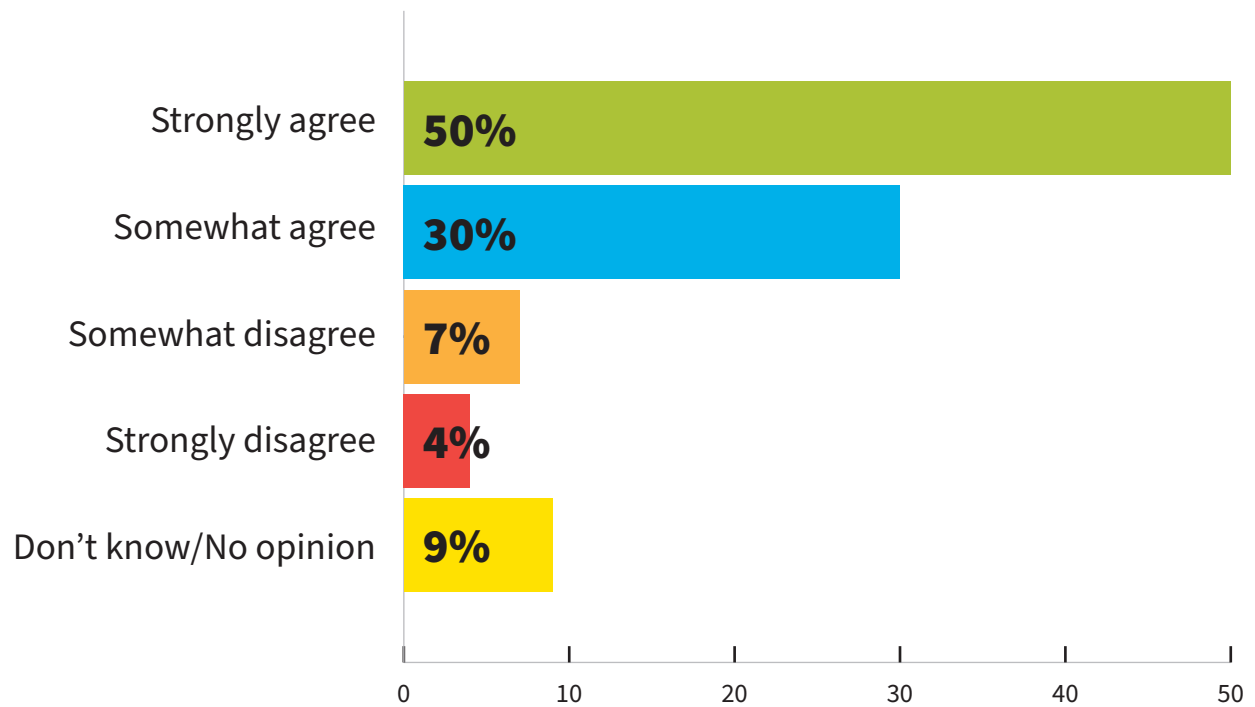

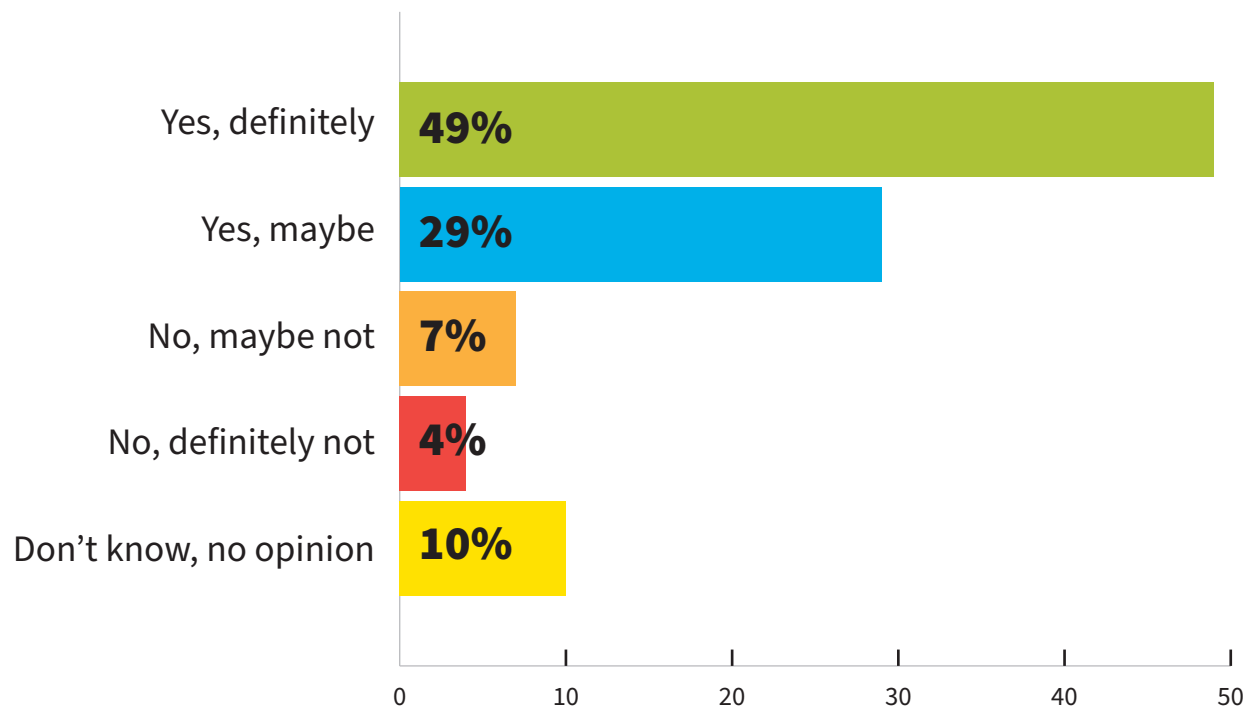
Do you agree or disagree that the federal government should be responsible for providing a basic income to all citizens?

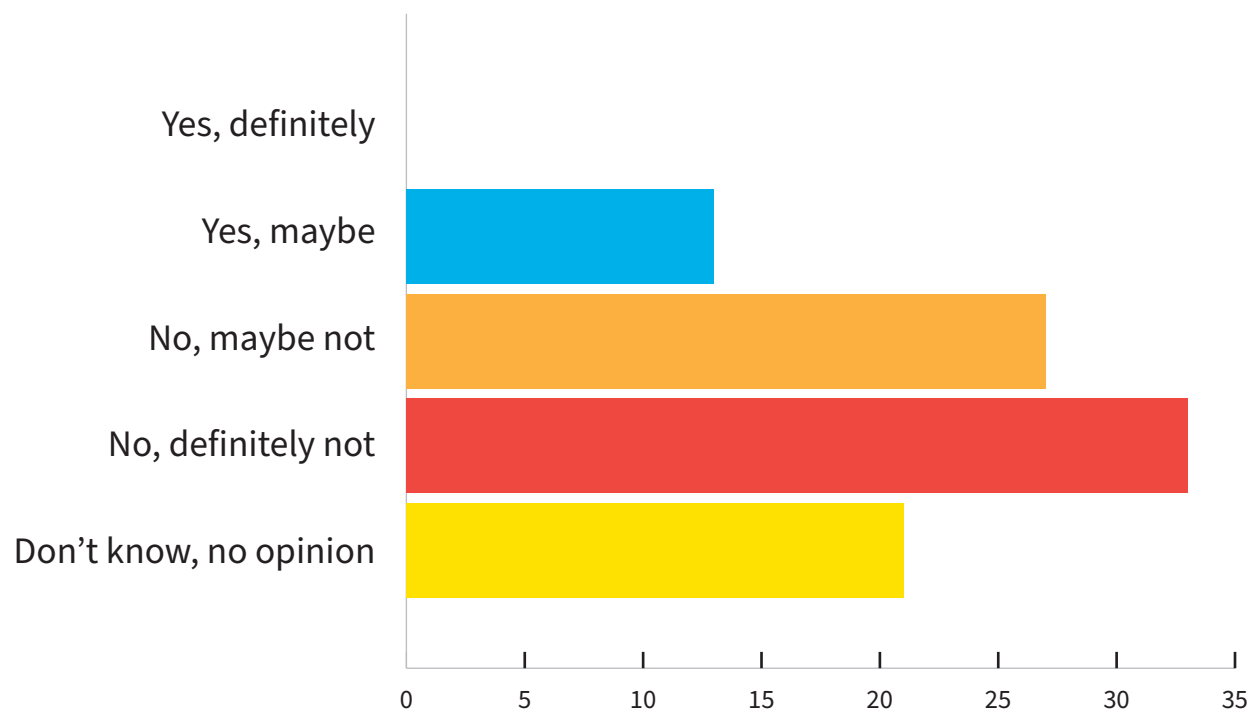
