

NAHB Remodeler of the Year Judging Criteria and Points Allocation

The NAHB Remodeler of the Year award recognizes superior business management, exemplary NAHB involvement at all levels and outstanding contributions to the remodeling industry.

The NAHB Remodeler of the Year is reviewed by a panel of seven judges comprised of national NAHB Remodelers subcommittee leader(s), the NAHB Remodeler's immediate past chair, a representative from the sponsor and the immediate past recipient. Judges will disqualify themselves if a member of their own council is an applicant. If any judge(s) has to be disqualified, the next most recent past Remodeler of the Year recipient(s) will be invited to participate.

Judging Criteria

Statements

- x Awards t In 150 words or less, describe: Any awards, recognition, or honors the nominee has received, including industry-related honors.

Local/State Association Involvement

- x Chair of local/state NAHB Remodelers
- x Committee member or Chair (other than remodelers) at local/state association
- x President or Director of local/state association
- x Executive Officer Verification: NAHB Remodelers will contact the local Executive Officer to verify local and state participation and ask for confidential letter of support.

NAHB National Involvement

- x NAHBR member 5+ years
- x Member or Chair of NAHBR Subcommittee
- x Trustee or Chair of NAHBR
- x Member or Chair of an NAHB committee; or National Director; or State Rep; or NAC
- x Earned NAHB Spike or Life Spike Credits

Education & Active/Current Designations

- x NAHB designations held: CAPS, CGR, GMR, CGP and/or Master CGP
- x Taken any of the following in the past five years: NAHB courses or education sessions at IBS or the Remodeling Show; NAHB Education webinar or NAHB Remodelers member webcast

Supporting Documents
